Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 110, dated 13.11.2014, under Sections 414, 411, 120-B and 489-A, 489-B and 489-C of IPC; 3, 34, 20 of Indian Passport Act, 14 of Foreigners Act, 3, 4, 5 of Official Secret Act, 66 of FIT Act, 18, 21, 22, 61 and 85 of NDPS Act, 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar, Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Kanwaljit Singh, very fairly conceded that in compliance of the order dated 12.03.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 12.03.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
