This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.223 dated 28.11.2012 under Sections 382/411/413 of the Indian Penal Code,1860 registered at Police Station Kotwali, Bathinda District Bathinda .

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the trial Court.
