Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.311 dated 16.11.2013, under Sections 324, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Ramamandi, Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**) and the subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 22.06.2014 and affidavit dated 17.01.2015 of the complainant-Rajesh Kumar (**Annexures P-2 and 3** respectively) arrived at between the parties.

Report from learned trial Court has already been received.

Learned State Counsel, however, points that that there is a partial compromise since another co-accused, namely, Happy @ Kuldeep, has not come forward.

In response, this fact is not in dispute.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
