Vide order dated 21.4.2015, this Court granted interim bail to the petitioner with a direction to join investigation and comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) CrPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 21.4.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gursharan Singh, does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and further submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in this case at this stage.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed

and the order dated 21.4.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when directed by the Investigating Officer and shall comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) CrPC.
