ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is a second petition filed by the petitioner-Gayatri, seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 219 dated 07.05.2013, registered under Sections 302, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar (Haryana).

The first bail application was dismissed on merits in October 2013.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner has been filed the petition for regular bail, but she presses her petition only with respect to the alternative relief. He further states that the petitioner was arrested on 08.05.2013 and the trial is proceeding at a snails pace and the trial Court may be directed to conclude it within a specified time frame.

The petitioner is in custody for almost two years and the trial has still not been concluded. Therefore, the petition is disposed of with the direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude it within four months preferably.
