As submitted on the last date by counsel for the respondent, time for filing the charge-sheet in the Court was extended up to 23.03.2015.

Today, it is reported, on instructions from HC Suresh Kumar, Police Station Bahaw Wala, that charge-sheet has been filed. However, it was filed yesterday, i.e. 25.03.2015. The charge-sheet, therefore, put in Court after the period of extension had expired.

The petitioner is, therefore, entitled to bail though the request has not been made under Section 167 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. Even otherwise, he is in custody since 06.07.2014.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court.
