Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 141, dated 02.12.2014, under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

There are serious allegations that the petitioner with a purpose to fleece the complainant and others, assured that he will purchase the land in Madhya Pradesh, Sopur. Taking the assurance of the petitioner, the

complainant and others have deposited the amount in the account of the petitioner. Now, there is no document brought on record that whether such land was in existence which could have been offered for sale to those persons, nor it is mentioned in the petition that the petitioner has suggested for the purchase of a particular land and its descriptions and particulars. It is common that innocent peoples are fleeced by these gullible persons.

In view of this, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
