Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Dilbagh Singh in case FIR No.82 dated 18.12.2014 for offence under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Old Shalley, District Gurdaspur.

The allegations against the petitioner is that he forged the revenue record for obtaining the loan of Rs.5,75,000/- from the complainant-Bank for purchase of a tractor in 2005, the petitioner is stated to have paid only a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- approximately.

This Court had granted him interim bail on his representing that the entire amount has been recovered by the bank.

On a subsequent date another opportunity was extended.

At the time of hearing today, learned Counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh states that the statement is incorrect and more than half the amount is still recoverable.

In view of the above, no ground for granting anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
