Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, namely, Harpreet Singh @ Lucky, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 148, 149 323, 341, 427 and 452 IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 27, dated 28.01.2015, registered at Police Station, City Barnala, District-Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the name of the petitioner has not been mentioned in the FIR and no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner nor any injury has been attributed to him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Nachatar Singh, very fairly states that the mother of the complainant was given a *danda blow* on her arm and such offence is bailable.

In view of the aforesaid stand, the petitioner is extended the concession of benefit of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. He shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
