Allowed, as prayed for, subject to all just exceptions. Section 409 IPC be also read in the head-note as well as prayer clause of the main petition.

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Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.349 (wrongly mentioned as 344 in the impugned order) dated 12.12.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, under Sections 409,

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420, 465, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 09.03.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from SI Ashwani Kumar, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 09.03.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
