This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the Criminal complaint No.290 dated 11.8.2007 titled as Hardeep Kaur v. Harwinder Singh @ Ladi and others under Sections 323, 324, 427, 452, 148, 149 IPC (Annexure P1) along with consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 8.1.2014 (Annexure P4).

Report of the the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala has been received. The learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant to the effect that she has effected compromise with the accused. The statements of all the accused except Pargat Singh have been recorded regarding the compromise.

Pargat Singh is stated to be proclaimed offender. It is stated that

compromise is without any pressure and coercion and is genuine.

Since the parties have effected compromise and the complainant is no more interested in pursuing the complaint, therefore, the Criminal complaint No.290 dated 11.8.2007 titled as Hardeep Kaur v. Harwinder Singh @ Ladi and others under Sections 323, 324, 427, 452, 148, 149 IPC (Annexure P1) along with the consequential proceedings, including declaring Pargat Singh as proclaimed offender stands quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
