This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.27 dated 3.4.2007 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC along with consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 8.1.2014 (Annexure P2).

Report of the the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala has been received. Statements of all the accused and complainant Harwinder Singh alias Laddi complainant injured have been recorded. It is reported that the parties have effected the compromise and the same is genuine, without pressure.

Since the parties have effected compromise and the complainant is no more interested in pursuing the matter, therefore, the FIR No.27 dated 3.4.2007 registered under Sections 324, 323,

148, 149 IPC along with the consequential proceedings, stands quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
