DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to the official respondents to add Section 392 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act in case FIR No.482 dated 21.12.2014 registered under Sections 147, 148, 452 and 427 IPC at Police Station Barwala, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR, in question, was registered at the instance of husband of the petitioner and in spite of making complaint by the petitioner, no action has been taken and the representation is still pending.

Admittedly, on the basis of same incident, the action has already been taken and the FIR has been registered. Petitioner has no *locus standi* to file this petition when the FIR has been registered on the basis of same incident at the instance of husband of the petitioner.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
