Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of a direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members, at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

On 22.07.2014 and 29.09.2014, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Even today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

In pursuance of notice of motion, respondent Nos.1 to 3 filed reply. In reply, it is mentioned that after seeking opinion of doctor concerned in respect of injured-petitioner, his statement was recorded in

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presence of his wife-Sukhwinder Kaur. Since non-cognizable offences were made out on the basis of statement of petitioner, DDR No.27 dated 20.01.2014 was recorded.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file criminal complaint in accordance with law.

It is also made clear that if the petitioner has any apprehension to his life and liberty, he can approach respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.B.S.Nagar, who will provide requisite security to the petitioner.
