AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondent to take immediate action against respondents No.4 to 18 in FIR No.198 dated 29.11.2014 registered under Sections 379, 427, 323, 148, 149, 506 IPC at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur and to submit the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel has argued that in this connection the petitioner has also moved representation (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.2 and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide his representation within

any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the S.S.P., Ferozepur is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-3) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
