This petition has been filed for grant of the anticipatory bail by petitioners in case FIR No. 152 dated 25.12.2014, under Sections 308, 452, 323 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Barnala, District Barnala.

As per prosecution allegations, the injury to Neetu has been caused by co-accused Rinku Nath. The role of present petitioners is that they only caught hold the victim.

Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Amrik Singh, Police Station, Barnala stated that both the petitioners have joined the investigation and have been interrogated. They are no longer required

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for any custodial interrogation. Thus, their detention will not serve any purpose.

Thus, the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 18.03.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Application stands disposed of.
