Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.277 dated 18.8.2014 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 307, 452, 320(8) IPC, registered at Police Station Chherretta, District Amritsar City and all subsequent proceedings flowing therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 12.2.2015 (Annexure P-2).

Mr. B.S. Jaswal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and submits that the respondents have

compromised only to the extent of bail application and not to the FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that since the petitioner is not stick to the terms of compromise deed dated 12.2.2015 entered between the parties, he be granted liberty to file fresh petition seeking quashing of FIR on merits instead of on the basis of compromise.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
