The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the official respondents to not harass the petitioner on the basis of a certain complaint and information having been furnished by respondent No.4.

It has been averred that the petitioner is a citizen of Canada possessing a Canadian passport and is presently residing in Ludhiana. Respondent No.4 namely Parminder Singh Lali is stated to have provided certain information as regards financial transactions made by one Balbir Singh i.e. brother-in-law of the petitioner and in favour of the petitioner. It is contended that on the basis of such information, respondent No.3 i.e. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Khanna is harassing the petitioner only with the oblique motive of extracting some money.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

The averments and assertions contained in the instant petition are utterly vague in nature. The same are not even substantiated in the light of relevant documents having been placed on record.

Be that as it may, the instant petition is disposed of with the observations that in the eventuality of the petitioner approaching respondent No.2 i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna as regards his grievance, respondent No.3 would be at liberty to consider the same and to take all such steps as deemed fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
