MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioners have been accused of having in their possession 105 bottles of liquor.

Learned counsel for the petitioners pleads false implication of the petitioners.

Be that as it may, the respondent contends that sufficient investigation has been undertaken and the petitioners have been interrogated.

If that is so, then I am of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by submitting the petitioners to the rigors of arrest. The petition is thus allowed with a direction that in the event of their arrest the petitioners shall be enlarged

on bail subject to complying with the following conditions :-

- i) They will make themselves available for investigation as and when required to do so.
- ii) They will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
- iii) They will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police official.
