This order shall dispose off CRM-M-6733-2015, titled Amit and another v. State of Haryana and CRM-M-6891-2015, titled Yashwinder Kuamr v. State of Haryana as both arise from the same FIR.

Present petitions have been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in a case arising out of FIR No. 430 dated 12.12.2014, under Sections 323,452, 406/34 IPC and Sections 324 and 326 IPC (added subsequently), registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that challan has been

presented and the case is fixed for framing of charge. Learned counsel further contends that petitioners Amit and Sumit are behind bars since 26.12.2014 and 22.12.2014 respectively, whereas petitioner Yashwinder Kumar is behind bars since 28.12.2014. learned counsel further contends that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioners can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, subject to their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.
