After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial court and apply for regular bail.

It is, however, directed that in case petitioner surrenders before the trial court within ten days from today and applies for regular bail, same shall be decided within a week thereafter.

Arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed till the decision of his bail application.
