TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C read with Section 482 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal complaint no.147 dated 10.4.2013/12.11.2013 under section 3 (1) (x) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Section 506 I.P.C.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition and makes a submission that the petitioners would duly surrender before the Trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and if thereafter, an application for regular bail is filed, the same be decided on the same very day.

As per prayer made by counsel, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is further observed that in case both the petitioners surrender before the Trial Court within the afore-noticed time frame and file an application seeking regular bail, the Trial Court would consider the same on merits and shall make every endeavor to expedite the hearing of the same.
