SNEH PRASHAR, J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 13 dated 20.01.2015, under Sections 457, 411 and 381 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station, Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur.

2. Precisely, the accusation against the petitioner is that the petitioner in connivance with Gurmeet Singh and Basant Singh, caretaker of the shop of spare part, being run by complainant- Phuman Singh, had committed theft of spare part worth Rs.1,02,350/-. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 20.01.2015. He is said to be a spare scrap dealer.

3. Learned State counsel submits that recovery has already been effected.

3. Heard the submissions made by Mandeep Singh Sodhi, Advocate, representing the petitioner and Mr. Y.K. Gupta, AAG, Punjab representing the State.

6. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances and lest any expression above may prejudice the case of either side, there being no plausible ground to detain the petitioner in custody, he is admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Area Magistrate/ Trial Court, Ferozepur.
