The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to respondent no.4 i.e. S.H.O., Police Station, Division No.2, Field Ganj, Ludhiana not to harass, humiliate and pressurize the petitioner and that too at the instance and in connivance with respondent no.5 i.e. Deepak Gupta, proprietor of M/s Mukesh Steel Pvt. Ltd. with whom the petitioner allegedly has certain business dealings.

Without even going into the correctness of the averments made in the instant petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same at the very initial stage with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana, respondent no.3 as regards his grievance and any apprehension that he is entertaining towards threat to his life and liberty.
