JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of Complaint No. 358-1 of 2010, dated 04.09.2010 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 323, 506 and 34 IPC, charge sheet dated 04.11.2014 (Annexure P-2), order dated 04.11.2014 (Annexure P-3) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 02.02.2015 (Annexure P-5).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise arrived at between the parties is a genuine and voluntary. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and Complaint No. 358-1 of 2010, dated 04.09.2010 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 323, 506 and 34 IPC, charge sheet dated 04.11.2014 (Annexure P-2), order dated 04.11.2014 (Annexure P-3) as well as all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
