SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The present petition under Section 438 of the of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.151 dated 4.9.2014 registered under Sections 451, 354, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana.

Mr.BP Singh, Advocate has appeared and filed his power of attorney on behalf of the complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection if the complainant is allowed to join the proceedings and impleaded as party. Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner in compliance with the order dated 12.3.2015 has joined the investigation and nothing remains to be recovered from him.

On instructions from HC Kulwinder Singh, the learned State counsel has conceded the said fact. She further informs that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required as nothing remains to be recovered from him.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.3.2015 vide which the petitioner was allowed interim bail is made absolute. She shall abide by the conditions as enshrined in Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
