The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 432, dated 17.7.2014, registered under Sections 376, 506 of the IPC, at Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that even as per the allegations, the complainant was staying with the petitioner for 10 years and it is thereafter that the allegations of rape were levelled and that the petitioner has now been in custody since 5.11.2014.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Amit Kumar, has accepted these factual assertions.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping

in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
