Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.85 dated 15.08.2009 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at the instance of complainant-respondent no.2 Lata Rani alleging that she was married to Karamjit Singh on 03.04.2009 but she was maltreated by her husband and other family members.

On the basis of compromise, the parties were directed to appear before Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been sent to the effect that the matter has been amicably resolved without any pressure or coercion.

Following the judgment in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, I do not find any ground to deny quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise in a matrimonial matter. Petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
