The petitioner is facing trial under Section 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003 in the Court of Mr. Phalit Sharma, Addl. Sessions Judge, Gurgaon. The petitioner could not appear on 17.10.2014. Therefore, his non-bailable warrants were issued. At the same time, four official witnesses who were present in the Court, had to be discharged.

In the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial court and move an application for grant of regular bail. The application, if moved, the same shall be decided on the same day. However, the trial court shall be at liberty to move against the petitioner under Section 446 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

However, if the bail application is declined, the petitioner shall not be arrested for the next 10 days to enable him to approach to this Court.
