Report dated 11.3.2015 sent by the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gidderbaha has been received, whereby, after recording statements of the petitioner Harmander Singh @ Mander as well as of complainant Baljeet Kaur w/o Gurmeet Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that both the sides are from the same very village and allegations against the accused are not of very serious nature, thus, to facilitate harmony and to bring about cordial relations and that the compromise will go a long way assuaging the feelings of wrong done and would remove all ill-will and hatred between the parties, FIR No.124 dated 03.11.2010 under Sections 452,323,427,148 and 149 IPC Police Station,

Gidderbaha District Muktsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
