The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.94 dated 21.10.2014 under Sections 452/326/324/323/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

Having argued the matter at some length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition and submits that the petitioner would duly surrender before the Investigating Agency. Counsel further submits that after surrendering and upon filing an application seeking the benefit of regular bail, directions be issued to the competent Court for deciding such application on the same very day.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is directed that in case, the petitioner surrenders within a period of one week from today and thereafter, files an application seeking benefit of regular bail, the competent Court would consider and deal with the same on merits and would make every endeavor to dispose of the same expeditiously.
