JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 179, dated 19.12.2004, under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur as well as all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise has been effected between complainant as well as accused with their own free will, without any threat, pressure, coercion and same is genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 179, dated 19.12.2004, under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioner.
