Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner Balvir Kumar @ Billu in case FIR No.21 dated 09.02.2014 under Sections 307, 323, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Division No.7, (Vardhman), District Ludhiana.

As per the allegations the petitioner is alleged to have inflicted a merciless blow on the right side of the Raman Kumar, brother of the complainant by a sharp edged *Iron Dattar*.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is in custody since 12.5.2014 and the charge is even yet to be framed while two other co-accused are on bail.

Learned State Counsel along with ASI Jagdeesh Singh has shown the case file, which reveals that the injury caused on the face of the

injured is a 15cm bone deep wound, declared dangerous to life.

In view of the gravity of offence no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
