Counsel for the petitioners submits that he would press the request for anticipatory bail for petitioner – Gurmeet Singh while regarding other two namely, Tejbir Singh and Amrik Singh, petition may be treated as withdrawn.

Petition on behalf of petitioners Tejbir Singh and Amrik Singh is dismissed as withdrawn.

So far as petitioner – Gurmeet Singh is concerned, he was stated to be armed with hockey and iron rod along with Harpal Singh and Harjinder Singh. No firearm was used by him, nor he was shown to be in possession of any firearm.

Counsel for petitioner – Gurmeet Singh has shown order dated 11.12.2014 whereby Dilbag Singh and Rajinder Singh whose role in the matter was allegedly similar to that of Gurmeet Singh, were granted anticipatory bail.

The matter is still under investigation and charge-sheet has yet

not been filed in the Court.

In view of the above, the request of petitioner – Gurmeet Singh is allowed. However, petitioner – Gurmeet Singh shall join investigation as and when required by the investigating officer.
