Learned counsel for respondent No.2 admits the factum of amicable settlement between complainant and the petitioner.

On 02.03.2015 following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that unfortunate incident occurred on account of eating peanuts in the Hospital and creating dirt in the premises which was objected to, by the complainant and thereafter some minor altercation took place.

He states that now the matter has been amicably settled by way of compromise dated 27.01.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”
