The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.186 dated 09.07.2014 under Sections 15/25/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 33 gunny bags containing 35 kgs. each of poppy husk has been made from the truck bearing registration No.MP-09-HF-8094. Further allegation is that two co-accused were apprehended on the spot and the petitioner along with 3 others ran away.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature. Heavy recovery of poppy husk has been made. Perusal of the order dated 12.02.2015 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar declining the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner reveals that he has already been declared as proclaimed offender on 27.01.2015 by the Court of SDJM,

Phillaur.

Under such circumstances, the petitioner is not held entitled for the concession of pre arrest bail.

Dismissed.
