This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.2, dated 19.01.2015, under Sections 13(1) (D) and 13(2) 88 of Prevention of Corruption Act, and Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Bathinda.

There are allegations against the petitioner that he, being a bank employee in connivance with co-accused prepared false and fabricated documents, resultantly amount to the tune of Rs.2,04,882,52.02 has been withdrawn from various accounts and got deposited in their own accounts. The matter is still under investigation and some of the co-accused are yet to be arrested.

In view of above facts and circumstances, no ground for grant of regular bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed at this stage.
