1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?
2. To be referred to reporters or not?

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.27, dated 27.05.2014 under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged possession is 55 grams of *Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride* which is more than marginally higher than the commercial quantity. He further submits that in the present case, charges have been framed.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI, Jagdish Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the case is now fixed on 20.07.2015 for prosecution witnesses and out of 08 witnesses, 01 witnesses has been examined.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, but considering the fact that trial will take long time and the alleged possession is slightly more than permissible limits, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.

Petition is disposed of.
