FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 26.5.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class Batala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Anil Sharma as well as of complainant Hoshiar Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and keeping in view that the complainant has since died and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.77 dated 18.07.2012 under Sections 452,309,506,427 IPC Police Station, Srihargobindpur, Batala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
