1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.127 dated 28.11.2014, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B, IPC, registered at Police Station Phase-II, Mohali (SAS Nagar) on the basis of compromise dated 06.02.2015 (Annexure P/2) alongwith subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

The parties have already placed on record a compromise dated 06.02.2015 as Annexure P/2 wherein, the parties have settled their respective claims by way of mutual and amicable settlement. As directed by this Court vide order dated 16.03.2015, parties have filed their respective affidavits reiterating the contents of compromise.

Learned State counsel has filed an affidavit of Navreet Singh Virk, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-II, District SAS, Nagar (Mohali) showing their ignorance of any such settlement between the parties.

Parties are present in person in the Court. Respondent No.2 namely, Navleen Kaur, who is complainant in this case though is not present in the Court, but her mother namely, Gurjinder Kaur, is present along with affidavit duly signed by her. She has been identified by her counsel namely Mr.H.S.Bedi, Advocate. The complainant is already a signatory of the compromise dated 06.02.2015 (Annexure P/2).

Considering that the matter has been settled between the parties for which compromise deed as well as separate affidavits have been filed, no further order is required.

Consequently, present petition is allowed and FIR No.127 dated 28.11.2014, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B, IPC, registered at Police Station Phase-II, Mohali (SAS Nagar) on the basis of compromise dated 06.02.2015 (Annexure P/2) alongwith subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.
