The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of order dated 10.10.2014 (Annexure P-1) as also order dated 5.1.2015 (Annexure P-2), passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar in terms of which two applications filed by the petitioner have been allowed partly to the extent of summoning certain defence witnesses.

Counsel having argued the matter at some length, prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to file appropriate applications before the Trial Court with better particulars and furnishing the requisite details.

Without going into the merits of the submissions raised by the counsel, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is, however observed that if any such application is filed under Section 233 Cr.P.C at the hands of the present petitioner, the same would be dealt with strictly in accordance with law.
