ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 1 dated 19.01.2014, registered under Sections 445, 45, 380 IPC at NRI Police Station, District Moga and consequent proceedings taken therein on the basis of compromise.

Report has been received from the trial court after recording statements of the parties on compromise. Trial Court has also sent copy of statements of petitioner and respondents no.2 and 3 recorded by it, which reveal that compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is the only accused and respondent nos.2 and 3, being the complainant and husband of the deceased, are the only aggrieved persons in the FIR.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements made by the parties and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble the Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2012(10) SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted therein are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise.
