This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.18 dated 23.3.2013 registered under sections 302, 364, 201, 34 I.P.C at Police Station, Maqboolpura, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

It has gone uncontroverted that apart from PW Navjot Singh, all other witnesses have turned hostile. In the case of co-accused namely Kamaldeep Singh @ Kamal, this Court on 10.2.2015 in CRM No. M-43244 of 2014 had passed a conditional order granting bail subject to PW Navjot Singh not appearing on 20.2.2015 which was the date fixed before the Trial Court. Since afore-noticed witness did not appear on the afore-noticed date, co-accused Kamaldeep Singh @ Kamal has been released on bail.

Learned State counsel would further apprise the Court that thereafter that matter was fixed for today i.e. 9.3.2015 and even today PW Navjot Singh has failed to appear. The matter has now been adjourned to 20.3.2015.

As such, in view of the facts noticed herein above and on the ground of parity itself the instant petition is disposed of with a direction that in case PW Navjot Singh does not even appear on 20.3.2015, Trial Court would release the present petitioners on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction after 20.3.2015.

Disposed of.
