By this order, I will dispose of two CRM Nos.M-7134 and 7136 of 2014.

The petitioner(s) has/have filed these petitions for quashing of summoning order dated 02.12.2013 passed in a criminal complaint No.94 of 18.11.2013, titled as "M/s Spectra Televentures vs. Mr. Bazmi R. Hussain", under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471,

477-A, 120-B and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Gurgaon.

Today in the Court, the memorandum of settlement between the parties, has been filed.

It is stated that under the compromise, respondent-complainant voluntarily forego and relinquishes all the claims over the material and machinery regarding Bhilai Steel Plant belonging to M/s. Spectra Televentures Pvt. Ltd. The parties have further agreed to accept the payment of ₹50,00,000/- (along with the matured value) lying deposited with this Court, in terms of the order dated 03.03.2014 passed in CRM-M No.7134 of 2014 as full and final settlement of all the outstanding amounts.

In view of the memorandum of settlement held between the parties, the summoning order dated 02.12.2013 passed in the complaint in question, stands quashed.

It is directed that ₹50,00,000/- (along with its matured value) lying deposited with this Court as per order dated 03.03.2014, are ordered to be paid to the respondent-complainant.

Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed.
