This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66, dated 09.03.2014 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120B IPC registered at Police Station Parao, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

The case was registered on the complaint of Ravinder Singh and the allegation was against Smt. Paramjit Kaur and also against her husband Gurwinder Singh. It was alleged that the complainant was the absolute owner of a certain parcel of land and had never entered into any agreement to sell the said land and afore mentioned Paramjit Kaur and Gurwinder Singh, had joined hands to obtain NOC in respect of two acres of land vide memo No.2683 dated 09.12.2013.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the name of

the present petitioner does not figure in the FIR. He has been subsequently implicated on account of statement of the complainant recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C.

It has also gone uncontroverted that the main accused i.e. Paramjit Kaur has been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail and her husband Gurwinder Singh has been granted the benefit of regular bail by this Court.

The petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2015.

Learned State counsel further apprise the Court that investigation is complete and the challan was presented on 28.01.2015. Thereafter the charges have been framed and the trial is still at the initial stage.

Present petition is allowed. Bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Ambala.

Disposed of.
