Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Lakhwinder Singh has submitted that petitioner has already been joined the investigation in compliance of the order dated April 28, 2015. This is a version and cross-version case and it is yet to be established as to which of the parties was an aggressive one.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties have arrived at compromise and have settled the dispute amicably with the intervention of the respectables. On the basis of compromise, petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of the FIR have already moved which is pending for disposal for recording statement of the parties by the trial Court.

In the given circumstances, petitioner is no more required for further interrogation. Accordingly, interim order dated April 28, 2015 is made absolute.
