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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is second bail application for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 40 dated 19.6.2014, registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC at Police Station Mullanpur Garib Dass, District SAS Nagar (Mohali). The first anticipatory bail application was dismissed by this Court on 26.11.2014 (Annexure-P-11).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pleaded that the fresh ground for filing the present petition is that now the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute and pay the money to the complainant and the offence is compoundable.

If it is so, there is no need of intervention of the High Court. The petitioner can always pay the money to the complainant either himself or through his brother-in-law Vikas Kumar, co-accused, who is on bail. There is no ground to review the order dated 26.11.2014 (Annexure-P-11), passed by this Court.

Dismissed.
