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**SNEH PRASHAR, J.**

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.15 dated 10.2.2015, registered under Sections 379, 420, 425, 427, 429, 431 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 21 of the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 and Sections 3 & 4 of Damage of Public Property Act at Police Station Rahon, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

On instructions from ASI Manohar Lal, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner in compliance with the order dated 4.3.2015 passed by this Court, has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 4.3.2015 vide which the petitioner was allowed interim bail is made absolute. He shall abide by the conditions as enshrined in Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
