Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing the respondents to expedite the investigation and to file the status report in case FIR No. 82 dated 12.02.2014, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh.
