Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.77 dated 24.09.2013, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the complainant states that recovery is to be effected from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that local commissioner was appointed, inventory has been prepared and report is available on record. He further states that custodial investigation is not necessary for effecting recovery and recovery can even otherwise be effected.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated . 07.03.2014 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
